Coxwell Self-Binding Path Gravel

The material has been established in the market place for the last ten years and has gained a reputation for its natural colour, low maintenance, very hardwearing surface and for being remarkably easy to lay.



It is screened to 30 mm down with sufficient fines to provide a fine, close textured surface when compacted. It is used extensively throughout Southern England and Wales on paths and cycle tracks in parks, country estates and gardens.

On selected applications, the material has even been laid using an asphalt paver.

Coxwell 5 mm Path Dressing

Coxwell 5 mm Path Dressing is similar to the Self-Binding Path Gravel but has a finer texture and is used extensively on golf courses.

Coxwell Pathway Sub-Base

To provide a hard base for the Coxwell Self-Binding Gravel, Grundon recommends the use of the Coxwell Sub-Base. Graded to 50 mm down, the material compacts well to form a sound, free-draining base for paths and walkways.

So if you are looking for a path material that will improve and mature with age, look no further.
