Grundon Waste Management Ltd operates a modern fleet of vacuum tankers, fitted with mild steel and stainless steel barrels, with capacities up to 27,200 litres (6,000 gallons).

Most types of liquid waste can be collected, including:

- Contaminated water from vehicle/plant washdown interceptors and effluent tanks
- Flammable solvent based paints, resins and adhesives
- Spray booth liquids and sludges
- Rinse waters, spent solutions and effluent sludges from metal plating/treatment processes
- Garage forecourt oil/water interceptors
- Pharmaceutical and pesticide contaminated liquids
- Sewage from domestic/commercial and industrial cess pits and septic tanks
- Grease traps from hotels, restaurants and canteens
- Food wastes (inc. vegetable oils) from bakeries, food factories, etc.

All Grundon tanker drivers are trained and licensed to carry Dangerous Goods by Road (A.D.R. trained). This enables them to collect and transport most hazardous liquids including caustic and flammable wastes.

To enable the collection of liquid wastes with a high solids content, and to clean interceptors and effluent tanks, Grundon offer a high pressure jetting service.

The name Grundon is our customers' assurance that the collection, transport, treatment and disposal of their wastes will be carried out in accordance with all legal requirements.



Recycling Services



Fluorescent Tube Recycling

The recycling of fluorescent light tubes is carried out to ensure compliance with all current and proposed waste management legislation. The methods employed meet the most stringent safety and environmental standards.

All key constituents such as the specialised glass, aluminium end caps and toxic mercury phosphor are recovered and recycled. Grundon are also able to recycle all halogen and sodium lamps.

For the safe on site storage and transportation of spent tubes and bulbs, Grundon offer a wide range of both metal and plastic storage containers.

Battery Recycling

Grundon recycle all Nickel Cadmium, Nickel Metal Hydride and Lithium ion batteries. They are sorted, segregated and where necessary drained at our Ewelme Transfer Station, in South Oxfordshire, prior to being transported to France for processing. Lead acid batteries are collected and recycled within the UK at approved metal recyclers.

Key constituents such as Lead, Cadmium, Ferrous Nickel, and Copper are all recycled.

Grundon supply a wide range of containers suitable for the storage, collection and transportation of waste batteries. Batteries must be segregated in compliance with the Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road Regulations 1996.

Fire Extinguisher Recycling

Grundon Waste Management offers a collection, transport and disposal service for almost all redundant fire extinguishers and gas cylinders. Empty/discharged units are 100% recycled through our Ewelme Transfer Station.

After an initial inspection the extinguishers/gas cylinders are dismantled and the sections bulked for recycling. LPG gases are also recovered and recycled through a unique piece of equipment at the Transfer Station.

All metal components such as steel cylinder bodies, brass valves and metal inner pipes are recycled by local approved metal recyclers.
