The Transfer Station excels at accepting mixed loads with a high emphasis on recycling. In addition, on site equipment and expertise enables us to provide specialist disposal methods for:

- Aerosols** → Processing plant for the recovery and recycling of all components. BAT compliant operation
- Batteries** → Segregating and recycling of individual cells and power packs including NiCd, NiMH, Li Ion Wet Cells and Lead Acids
- Packaged Wastes** → De-packing of all liquid wastes up to 25 litres including paints, adhesives, pesticides, low and non-hazardous liquids
- Lab Smalls** → Segregation and disposal by most appropriate method
- Pharmaceuticals** → Sort, segregate and dispose of all components by most appropriate method including high temperature incineration
- Shredding** → For security and destruction or volume reduction
- Fluorescent Tube Recycling** → Filtered crushing for recovery of components
- Further Recycling Options** → Metals / Oils / Solvents / Chlorinated Solvents / Fridges / Electronic Equipment

- Disposal of bulk aqueous waste streams at our Treatment Plant near Cheltenham
