

# Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Recycling Service



The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations (WEEE) came into force in 2007. These regulations are designed to tackle the ever-increasing volume of WEEE generated every year, obligating the waste producer to ensure their WEE is segregated, recovered and recycled.

As part of these regulations, it is also a legal requirement to separate any WEEE that contains hazardous components from the general waste stream. This includes items such as computer screens, televisions, cathode ray tubes, fridges and freezers, equipment containing many types of batteries, fluorescent tubes and printed circuit boards.

These are classified as hazardous wastes and therefore should be collected and disposed of in accordance with the Hazardous Waste Regulations 2009.

Grundon Waste Management offers a total WEEE management service, that starts with guidance on how to segregate and store WEEE, includes a listing, assessment and collection service and ends with the recovery and recycling of the WEEE, backed up by a full audit trail.
