

Privacy Policy

Use of Information

Grundon Waste Management Limited and Grundon Sand & Gravel Limited ('Grundon') will respect and protect your privacy. Through this statement we would like to inform you of our privacy policy and practices, including how information is collected online and how that information is used. Grundon will not collect any personal information about you, except where it relates to your work and is specifically and knowingly provided by you.

The information collected will only be used to send you the information you have requested and to provide information that we believe you may find both relevant and useful. Grundon will not sell or share any information about individual users with third parties.

Cookies

Cookies are pieces of information that are stored on your computer's hard drive by your web browser. Cookies can make the internet more useful by storing information about your preferences on particular sites, thus enabling site owners to provide more useful features for their users. Most browsers accept cookies automatically, but you can alter the settings of your browser to prevent automatic acceptance. If you choose not to receive cookies you may not be able to take full advantage of the website. We may use cookies for several reasons, for example to help us track usage patterns in order to improve and manage the website, or to record preferences in order to personalise your visit.

On revisiting this website our computer server will recognise the cookie, giving us information about your last visit. This does not recognise you as an individual, but only the computer that is being used to view the site.

Your Rights

In addition to Grundon's own security safeguards, your personal data is protected in the UK by the Data Protection Act 1998. This covers the storage and disclosure of any information individuals have provided, and the prevention of unauthorised access to such information. Amongst other things this states that the data we hold about you should be processed lawfully and fairly. It should be accurate, relevant and not excessive. The information should be kept up to date, where necessary, and not retained for longer than is necessary. It should be kept securely to prevent unauthorised access by other people.
