Applied for and obtained a WML for transfer of liquid, dry and 'Special' wastes in January 1995. Negotiated voluntary restriction on hazardous waste inputs with the EA in August 2005 to prevent the site transferring into the PPC Regime. An application to further limit the approved quantity of wastes was submitted to the EA in March 2009 and Permit Variation Notice EPR/ZP3899EU/V003 was issued on 9th April 2009 to Permit Number EPR/ZP3899EU.
OCC/153 WML86116	Banbury (Thorpe Mead) Transfer Station	Acquired from Shanks in 2003. Application for transfer of WML submitted and determined in favour of Grundon Waste Management Ltd.
WML86265	Beenham MRF, Reading	Planning Permission and WML obtained in 2001 / 2002 respectively. WML modified on 7th November 2008 to incorporate requirements for the storage and treatment of WEEE. No other changes to operational conditions.
WML83440	Tanhouse MRF (Colnbrook) Heathrow, London	Planning Permission obtained in 2002 and WML issued in 2003.
WML86235 (WML86349)	Ewelme MRF Wallingford	Planning Permission obtained in 1998 and WML issued in 1999. Application to extent licensed area submitted mid 2004, allocated WML86349 and issued in January 2005.
WML83513	Mole Valley MRF Leatherhead	Planning Permission for MRF obtained in 2003. An exemption from WML has allowed the site to commence operations pending the determination of the WML application, which was issued in July 2005.
EPR/DP3392LN	Wingmoor MRF Cheltenham	Planning permission for 50,000 tonne per annum MRF obtained in March 2006. Construction completed January 2009. In November 2008 an application was made to vary the old WML (EP) 48023 to include the new MRF. The varied permit, EPR/DP3392LN was issued on 23rd March 2009 and incorporated a standard rules permit for a 75,000 tonnes per annum MRF.

WML86140 BW0266G/HP3937LH (EAWML86386)	Ewelme No. 2 Landfill Wallingford	Planning Permission obtained in 1989, as a development of much earlier permissions for landfill dating back to 1930's. WDL issued in 1991 with substantial modification in 1994. Transfer to WML in 2001. PPC Permit for an inert landfill was submitted in December 2003 (Tranche 2B) and Permit BW0266 was issued in December 2004 (EAWML86386). A small part of the site remains within WML and we submitted an application to limit this WML to inert only for restoration purposes. Application approved and modified WML issued by the EA on 1st September 2005. Permit BQ0266G varied by EA to include new template conditions in January 2007, variation no. HP3937LH. WML registered exemption for land treatment (spreading of compost) ref TF1/002806, 31 January 2006 for 12 months. WML registered exemption for manufacture of products from waste ref TF1/002916, 28 March 2006, time limit not specified.
WML83301 CP3435PR TP3030LN VP3139MZ	Star Works Landfill (Knowl Hill) Maidenhead	Planning Permission issued in 1998 at Appeal, following rejection of initial submission. WML issued in 1998. PPC Permit application submitted April 2004 and determined in May 2005. Variation to Permit issued 14th November 2005 (TP3030LN) to correct errors in original, but no material change. Permit Variation VP3139MZ issued on 12th October 2007 after an EA initiated variation to adopt the new Permit template conditions.
BU3671IY FP3537SG GP3538MM	Wingmoor Farm West Landfill Cheltenham	Planning Permission secured in 1989 for a major landfill development. Subsequent modifications approved for clay extraction in 1990, ash plant in 1994, re-phasing and revised restoration profiles in 1995 plus ancillary permissions allied to sand and gravel extraction. Waste Disposal Licence issued 1990, varied on numerous occasions. PPC Permit application submitted in July 2003, hazwaste Permit issued 16th September 2004. WML 48236 used in lieu of BU3671 by local EA office due to technical problems on EA system. Application to modify hazwaste Permit BU3671 submitted to the EA in August 2005, to allow 3x derogation of full WAC for treated residues from the APC treatment plant. Variation issued 8th May 2006, number FP3537SG. Application for a minor variation submitted in June 2009, to address discrepancies in reporting thresholds for monitoring points and to amend permitted EWC codes further to EA guidance.
MP3531UM Variation No. FP3137UB	Wingmoor Quarry Landfill Cheltenham, Glos	Landfill site acquired in 2001, immediately adjoining Bishops Cleeve Landfill. WML transferred to Grundon, including new requirement for Financial Provision. PPC Permit submitted 9th November 2004 and Permit YP3439SM was issued in June 2005. Wingmoor Quarry Permit consolidated with the Wingmoor Farm East Permit on 26th September 2007. This Permit was immediately varied as part of the EA initiated Landfill Permit template review.

WML86112 PPC Ref WP3231SX	Ewelme Transfer Station Wallingford	Deemed Planning Permission by virtue of conditions contained within very early permissions for landfill. Activity ratified by issue of Waste Disposal Licence in 1994, transferring to WML in 2001. Submissions for new Planning Application are being considered by the relevant authorities. PPC Permit Application for substantial new facility submitted to EA in August 2005 and determined on 14th September 2007.
WML83479 PPC Permit YP3237SD Variation Notice Number WP3632UA	Star Works Autoclave (Knowl Hill) Maidenhead	Deemed Planning Permission for B2 use by virtue of previous use as brick and tile works. WML application submitted in early 2004 for 23,000 tonnes per annum of clinical and ABP wastes, to be treated through 2 no. H250 Hydroclave units. WML issued in December 2004. PPC Permit YP3237SD issued 28th September 2006, to allow acceptance of in excess of 10 tonnes of hazardous waste per day. PPC Permit variation issued 19th April 2010 to allow external storage of waste, subject to conditions.
BT2866/KP3333LW AH9987/AV1327 CE4317 EPR/BT2866G/V003	Clinical Waste Incinerator (Colnbrook) Heathrow, London	Planning Permission was submitted in 1999 for a 400,000 tonnes per annum mass burn Energy from Waste Facility, 40,000 tonnes per annum MRF and a 10,000 tonnes per annum clinical waste incinerator. The Permissions were granted in 2000 and IPC Authorisations were issued in 2000. Applications for PPC Permits were submitted in 2002 and have been determined by the EA in November 2003. Application to modify BT2866 submitted to Agency on 15th September 2005 to modify the original Permit. Variation KP3333LW issued 16th August 2006. Authorisation for radioactive waste transferred from the old CWI, with no amendments. Radioactive Waste Authorisation AH9987/CB2954 issued 20th July 2007 (revoking AH9987/CA2592) with enhanced capability for alpha, beta and gamma emitters. Authorisation varied by Grundon in March 2010 to increase the limits for certain waste types to meet customer demands. During the variation process, the UK regulations changed and the Radioactive Substance Act 1993 Regulations were superseded by the Environmental Permitting Regulations. This permit (CE4317) came into force on 20th May 2010. Minor variation to CWI Permit to amend the averaging period for carbon dioxide emissions and other minor changes. Application dated 28th March 2009 was accepted and Permit Variation EA/EPR/BT2866G/V003 issued on 3rd July 2009.

BT7116IW EA/EPR/BT7116IW/V002	Energy from Waste Facility (Lakeside, Colnbrook) Heathrow, London	Planning Permission was submitted in 1999 for a 400,000 tonnes per annum mass burn Energy from Waste Facility, 40,000 tonnes per annum MRF and a 10,000 tonnes per annum clinical waste incinerator. The Permissions were granted in 2000 and IPC Authorisations were issued in 2000. Applications for PPC Permits were submitted in 2002 and have been determined by the EA in November 2003. Application made in April 2009 for a minor variation to address differences between the Permit application and the completed facility, as well as amend the averaging period for carbon dioxide emissions. Permit Variation V002 issued in September 2009.

Exemption Ref No. EA/EPR/JP3794UW/A001	Beenham, Reading	Planning Permission obtained in 2002 and in 2003 a WML was issued for green waste composting. In February 2009 the composting operation ceased and has been replaced by an alternative green waste treatment / shredding operation, operating under a Paragraph 21 exemption from the EP Regs.
