UNDERSTANDING the risks

Healthcare settings are fast-paced, increasing the likelihood of accidental needle-stick injuries and the potential for cross-contamination. Sharps waste containers play a critical role in minimising these risks. Once the containers reach their designated fill line, they must be securely locked, clearly labelled and stored in a designated area for collection by licensed waste providers.

STAYING compliant



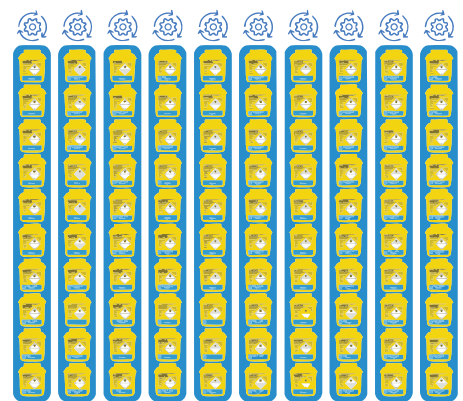
As a healthcare provider, compliance with sharps disposal regulations is your responsibility. The reusable sharps containers provided are **UN-approved, ISO 23907-2:2019 Part 2: Reusable Sharps Containers** certified, and fully align with health and safety standards.

The colour-coded design helps healthcare staff quickly identify waste types, streamlining waste segregation and reducing errors.

ENVIRONMENTAL responsibility

Sustainability is a growing priority within healthcare, as outlined in the NHS clinical waste strategy. Reusable sharps containers can cut carbon emissions by up to 87% compared to single-use alternatives.

Designed for up to 100 reuse cycles, these containers ensure that only the sharps waste inside is disposed of when full. By sanitising and reusing the containers, the need for virgin plastics is significantly reduced, supporting long-term sustainability goals.

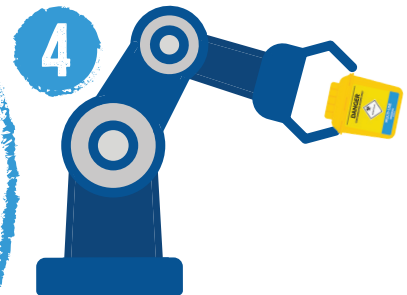
